I. Achievement of project's objectives

The objective (*Achievement of the contrastive approach*) was **integrally** achieved, including the supposed (the print of a book chapter on colonization in Moesia Inferior and the setting of some global conclusions: can Moesia Inferior be a model of colonization?). As results we previewed the print of an article in an IDB-journal, of a book chapter, participation in international conferences and the publication of a book on the project's theme. **All these results were not only achieved, but overcome.** The most important result was the book, *Migration, Kolonisierung, Akkulturation im Balkanraum und im Osten des Mittelmeerraumes*, Hartung Gorre Publishing House, Konstanz. The volume includes contributions of scientists from Romania, Germany, Bulgaria, Serbia, Kosovo and Mexico. There are many articles published by project's members (Lucrețiu Mihailescu-Bîrliba, Valentin Piftor, *Les étrangers dans l'élite locale de Troesmis*, Iulia Dumitrache, *Les Cocceii en Scythie Mineure*, George Nuțu, Lucrețiu Mihailescu-Bîrliba, George Nuțu, *Late Roman and Early Byzantine Lamps from (L)Ibida*). The project had also external contributors, non-members were interested and published inside the project. A valuable book on colonization in the military milieu of Pannonia was written and published by Ionuț Acrudoae, *Militari originari din Pannonia în armata romană. Studiu prosopografic*, Editura Universității „Alexandru Ioan Cuza”, Iași.

CONCLUSIONS

I. Results:

The project *The dynamics of colonization in the civilian and military milieu of the Roman province Moesia Inferior. A model of a contrastive approach (Dinamica fenomenului colonizator în mediul civil și militar al provinciei romane Moesia Inferior. Un model de abordare contrastivă)* has some important results:

- 1) The province Moesia Inferior can represent a model in the militaries' role in colonization.
- 2) In the rural milieu, Moesia Inferior can represent a model of romanization of this milieu.
- 3) In the urban and civilian milieu, Moesia Inferior does not find itself in a certain model.
- 4) The contrastive approach concerned especially Germania Superior, but there were studies also for Dacia or Pannonia. Germania Superior is a province with many soldiers, but with a powerful class of indigenous merchants.
- 5) Concretely, publications and participations in international conferences are as follows:

- 6) Project's impact was certainly **international**. Two books, 21 articles and 25 participations in conferences were international.
